Answer Call (Do not put call on hold) *Press Transfer Button* Press Extension Key or Dial Extension Example (12)

Stay on the line if you would like to inform end party who is on the call once you hang up the call is transferred

Transfer Call Directly to Voicemail:

Answer Call (Do not put call on hold) *Press Transfer Dial 7* Press Extension Key or Dial Extension Example (12) Hang up phone

Conference Call:

Dial First Call Place on Hold Dial Second Call Press Conference Button

Speed Dial:

Press Contacts Start Dialing name of Speed Dial: (Example ZACK would be 9225) Press Call button under Display

Back To Home Screen:

Hit Phone/ Exit Button at any time to get back to main Screen

Call Park:

Answer call press Call Park button will flash. Go to another phone and Press the Call Park Button

Initialize Mailbox: Press Message Button Press Select Press Select Listen to Instruction on how to record name Press 1 After you record your name Press # to d name
